World Renew: Uganda - Violence in South Sudan has forced families to flee to Uganda. With many such refugees suffering from diarrhea and other diseases, sanitation issues have emerged in refugee camps. In response, World Renew is building latrines in the refugee camp of Bidibidi. Pray for the refugees' safety and for a decrease in the spread of disease.

Christian Reformed World Missions: Christmas - Being away from home in the Christmas season is often one of the hardest parts of being a missionary. Pray that missionaries will experience God's presence this Christmas and find ways to enjoy the season in a different culture.

Chaplaincy and Care: Long-term care - A growing number of our chaplains today work in retirement villages, nursing homes, and long-term care facilities. Pray that they may be a light of hope and encouragement for people in the sunset years of their lives.

Christian Reformed Home Missions: Go Local learning communities - The two-year Go Local process forms regional learning communities of congregational teams and pastors to discover how to join God at work in local neighborhoods. Pray for the churches and leaders involved as they share what they learn. The first West Michigan Go Local learning community began in September 2016; others will soon launch in Ontario and in western Canada.

Back to God Ministries International: South Korea - Our ministry partner in South Korea, Far East Broadcasting Company, has invited us to broadcast our Russian programming on their AM radio station to Russian-speaking areas. Preliminary tests show that the coverage throughout Russia and Siberia is very good. Pray that this endeavor may be effective in reaching communities that don't have reliable Internet access or a local radio station.

Christian Reformed World Missions: Asia - Many people in Asia are eager to learn the English language for business reasons. Pray that churches and missionaries in Asia will find opportunities to help meet this need through the church and its outreach ministries.

World Renew: Nigeria - Thousands of people in Nigeria live with disabilities as a result of accidents, polio, diabetes, and other diseases. Many are discriminated against and live isolated lives. World Renew partners with The Beautiful Gate Handicapped People Center to provide aids such as wheelchairs and prosthetics to persons in need. Please pray for these individuals as they seek assistance and make positive changes in their lives.
