Dear Friends,

The genealogy in Matthew 1 provides us with a list of "light bearers." These are the various saints who God used to prepare the way until Jesus, the true Light of the world, came into the world. In this service we walk through Matthew's genealogy and highlight a few of the light bearers he lists. We do this through Scripture readings and songs that help us see why their particular light shone so brightly.

In the reading of Matthew 1:1-17 we will meet 46 people whose lifetimes span 2,000 years. Each candle we light represents one of these 46 people – all ancestors of Jesus. And although they varied considerably in personality, spirituality, and experience, all were used by God to fulfill the prophecies about the Messiah's line.

Tonight, we take time to remember these 'light bearers.' Yet, most importantly, we gather here tonight to worship the One True Light. The One who said, "I am the Light of the world. Whoever follows me will never walk in darkness, but will have the light of life" (John 8:12). ... May God bless us as we worship Him together this evening.
