Dear Friends,

Around the world today many Christians still endure severe persecution. Here in the United States we are fortunate that physical persecution is rare. However, many of us are familiar with cultural pressure and/or oppression.

In the book of I Peter, the apostle Peter reminds us that Christians are *aliens* and *exiles* in an often-hostile empire. Yet, at the same time, we are also chosen by God and equipped by Jesus' work 'for' us and 'in' us to live faithfully in our dual identity.

In the weeks to come we will explore how the work of Christ enables us to live with hope, joy, and faithfulness in an often antagonistic world. Peter reminds us that the kind of life that pleases God is one that includes respect for authorities (even when they are unjust!); godly behavior in the home; and by God's grace – good deeds, courage, and a firm faith in the midst of life's trials.

Ministry Opportunity: "Underground Ministries" is a local ministry that seeks to support those coming out of prison as they reenter into society. Part of their ministry model is to match one prisoner with a core group of 5-7 members of a local church to walk alongside and support them upon their release from prison. The relationship itself already begins approximately 12-18 months before the inmate is released by way of letters, emails, and Zoom meetings. The hope is that the relationship will then continue well after the release date itself. The Evangelism Committee has recently received the blessing from council to become a "One Parish/One Prisoner" support team and to also begin to gather a 'core group' of First CRC members who are feeling led by God to play an active role in this ministry. OTHER REQUESTS: (CRC Communications)

(World Renew: Human trafficking) Every 30 seconds, a child is trafficked. One in seven girls is married before age 15. Over 600 million women live in regions where domestic violence is not illegal. World Renew works to help bring justice where there is inequity, training families of the dangers of child trafficking, and working with government officials to help end these systemic issues. Ask God to bring justice in these areas.

(Resonate: Nova Scotia) Pray for Sam K., a Resonate missionary serving in Halifax, N.S. Because of the pandemic, people were confined to their 18-story apartment complex, which has been the location of Sam's ministry. Ask the Holy Spirit to continue working in this community, and pray that more people will come to know Jesus and grow in relationship with him.

(Faith Formation Ministries: Relationships) We give thanks for God's provision and opportunity to partner with the RCA's Next Generation Engagement on expanding Generation Spark, an intergenerational mentoring initiative. Pray for intergenerational relationships that strengthen the church and lead to long-lasting enrichment in churches and their communities.

(ReFrame: Burkina Faso) Pray for Matthieu in his faith journey. He recently traveled to our French ministry team in Burkina Faso to ask about the Christian faith. A former Muslim, he has been learning through our French radio programs about what it means to follow Christ.

(World Renew: Refugee resettlement) Many of today's 26 million refugees are burdened by hunger and poverty, and the COVID-19 pandemic has made difficult living conditions even harder. Please pray that God will keep these vulnerable families safe, providing food, shelter, and good health. Pray also that government officials will see the importance of allowing refugee travel.

(**Resonate: Japan**) Less than one percent of Japan's population are professing Christians. Resonate missionaries Ken and Jeannie Lee in Japan ask for prayers that God may "impart grace to his people that will enable them to live out their faith in everyday life." Ask the Holy Spirit to work in and through Christians in Japan to draw many more people into a relationship with Christ.
